By-Law No. 24R.

To amend By-Law concerning the construction of buildings.

(Drawn up in the French Language)

At a meeting of the Municipal Council of the City of Quebec, held in the City Hall, on the twelfth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four (1924), in conformity with the law, and in virtue of a By-law passed by this Council pursuant thereto, and after the due observance of all the formalities prescribed by the statute in such case made and provided, at which meeting were present the absolute majority of the members composing the Council of the City of Quebec, that is to say:

It is ordained and enacted by this Council and this Council ordains and enacts as follows, to wit:

1. Article 67a of By-law No. 24L, passed the 27th October, 1922, is amended by replacing paragraph C of said article by the following paragraph:

C. Along the said streets and avenues it shall be forbidden to erect or to run any manufacture, forge, workshop, commercial or industrial establishment, such as slaughter houses, tanneries, incinerators, brick factory, or lime kilns, stone quarries, glue, or soap or tar factories or tarred paper, storage buildings, cow stables, or stables.

2. The present By-law is declared forming part of By-law No. 24L.
